Surprise Endings

The best surprise ending of any story, especially any true story, is the one that ends like this:

They found the stone rolled away from the tomb, but when they went in, they did not find the body. While they were perplexed about this, suddenly two men in dazzling clothes stood beside them. The women were terrified and bowed their faces to the ground, but the men said to them, "Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here, but has risen.

Luke 22:2-5

This is the first Easter surprise in the Scriptures. But it isn't the last. The first Easter shatters what has always been the perfectly predictable ending to every human story. Now, on this side of Jesus' empty tomb, God continues to rewrite surprises into the ways our stories unfold.

Our world is still awash in death. We're reminded of that fact every day. In two years COVID has killed nearly one million people in our country and more than six million worldwide. The horrific images of the Russian invasion of Ukraine remind us of our never-ending capacity to inflict suffering and death on one another. Several tragedies and deaths of loved ones in our own community remind us that death is never far away.

We come to the cross of Jesus this month to be reminded that not even the Son of God escaped death. His closest friends and followers assumed that his crucifixion was just one more inevitable conclusion to an all too brief demonstration of what God's Will for humanity looks like. Then came Easter morning. The women who came to the tomb expecting to find Jesus' body met two men in dazzling clothes who shocked them with the unimaginable announcement, He is not here, but has risen.

Our Easter hope is that this isn't just an ancient story with an unbelievable plot twist. By the grace of God, the Easter story has become our story. It's the story of those we've loved and lost. Jesus won the victory over death for us. As composer John Ylvisaker wrote in his beloved song,

When the evening gently closes in and you shut your weary eyes, I'll be there as I have always been, with just one more surprise.

Hope to see you this month at the Cross and the Empty Tomb. Pastor JE




