Last week, Katherine and I attended a Minnesota Twins baseball game at Target Field in Minneapolis. For several innings, the four men in front of us loudly discussed their current jobs, recent interviews for new jobs, and the pros and cons of their career paths. Their conversation got me to thinking about all the years I wondered what kind of work I would do, and, once decided, if it would be a good fit with my interests and abilities. Would it be satisfying? Meaningful? Would God provide guidance? Inspiration? How would I know when it was time to move from one job to the next?

It seems strange--and surprising--to reach this point in my life when I am mostly on the back side of the questions those young men were asking. As most of you reading this know by now, I will be completing my call to Spirit of Joy at the end of this month and retiring from full time work as a pastor. With great gratitude, I can look

back now and answer those questions that were so prominent leading up to and during my working years.

I am grateful that for the past forty years, my work has been satisfying, meaningful and challenging. Looking back, I see the ways the Holy Spirit has been in the middle of it all: equipping, calling, guiding, inspiring, forgiving, healing, and accompanying me with grace and love. Such grace and love have been revealed week after week in the Word we've heard together, in the waters of baptism poured over us, and in the meal we've shared at the Lord's Table.

The greatest gift of these past years has been the opportunities to share and receive God's grace and love with the communion of saints—the people of God I've accompanied on their journeys of faith. What a remarkable privilege to be welcomed into people's lives, learn their stories, discern the ways God is inviting us into God's Great Story, be present in times of great joy and painful suffering and sorrow, and determine how to witness to the hope and joy available to all persons in Jesus Christ.

These last 22 years as mission developer and pastor of Spirit of Joy have been the most challenging and rewarding of all my calls. I am filled with gratitude to so many of you who have participated in the birth and vibrant life of Spirit of Joy: to my family who left a settled life in Wisconsin to enter the great unknown of church planting, and supported me through every high and low; to those first pioneers who took a chance on joining a congregation not much more than a dream in the beginning; and to all the faithful partners who have participated with the Holy Spirit in becoming Spirit of Joy with the gifts of your time, your amazing variety of talents and expertise, and your extravagant generosity over the past two decades. You are a blessing.
