Coaching for Joy



This summer someone paid **\$3.3 million** to have lunch with Warren Buffett. For the past two decades, the "Oracle from Omaha" has made himself available for lunch in New York via a charity auction. The

winner of this year's auction will be able to invite seven others to join Buffett for a good meal and conversation. All of the proceeds from the auction will benefit Glide, a San Francisco based charity that addresses poverty and homelessness.

Why so much for a single meal? It's not the food, though I'm sure it's delicious. It's not the charity, though they do good work. The appeal, of course, is the opportunity to sit down with a man who is one of the most successful investors who ever lived and to receive some personal investment coaching.

If you had the means to submit the winning bid for a lunch with the world's foremost coach of any one skill or practice, what skill and coach would you choose? Playing basketball with LeBron James? A voice lesson with Adele? An acting lesson from Tom Hanks? Decorating ideas from Chip and Joanna Gaines?

What if your priority was soul formation? Who would you choose as your oracle or guru or coach? The thing that is different about soul formation, also called spiritual formation, is that our hearts and souls are always being shaped in some way whether we intentionally choose a coach or not. You and I could choose to learn more about the skills and practices mentioned above or ignore them completely. Not so with formation of our souls—it is always ongoing—which makes choosing a coach a bit more vital.

For this reason, I want to invite you to come and dine with the world's foremost authority on joyful living as soulful living. No need to submit a bid, and there is always room at his table for you. Come and dine with Jesus this Sunday or any Sunday, listen to his words, and remember his promise, **"I have said these things to you so that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be complete"** (John 15:11).

Leadership Team Meeting Minutes

Thursday, June 28, 2018

Unfinished Business:

- **I. Building Expansion Timeline Update -** we may need to move the congregation building expansion meeting and vote to August in order to accomplish all that we hope to this fall. Pastor Jeff will be in touch with revised meeting dates and times.
- **II. Gift for Laura Phillip's Ordination** the Leadership Team agreed that a stoll would be an appropriate gift from her home congregation.

New Business:

 I. Capital Campaign - Leadership Team may need to meet earlier or via conference call to vote on the recommendations from the Capital Campaign Team as to which firm to hire to lead SoJ in the campaign process.

ll. Benevolence Payments: Pam Walton moved to make the following benevolence payments, Greg Bertsch second. Motion carries:

- **I.** Lutheran Social Services \$1,000
- **II.** Shetek \$1,000
- **III.** Lutherans Outdoors \$1,000

IV. Gift of a vehicle - a partner has generously offered to gift Spirit of Joy a minivan with the hope that the congregation can transport members who are no longer able to drive. The Leadership Team agreed that we should accept this generous donation.



IT IS TIME! Partners will have an opportunity to **VOTE AT 6:30PM ON SUNDAY, AUGUST 26,** when we will make the decision to build or not to build.

During the visioning process almost two years ago, a need to expand our facilities was identified. Last summer a committee was put together to further explore our needs and options. In December, the congregation voted to hire an architectural team. After many conversations and workshops with leaders and partners, we started putting our ideas to paper. The "storyboards" on display at the church detail this journey. There is also a conceptual drawing of what a new sanctuary might look like (a first draft that is our conversation starter).

At the time of this printing, interviews for a construction manager and capital campaign consultant are being held. Work is also being done on putting together a financial package. In early August the building team will meet to prepare recommendations that will then be submitted to the Leadership Team. On August 13 the Leadership Team will then vote on a plan that will be presented to the congregation at 6:30pm on SUNDAY, AUGUST 26. Partners will vote first on whether to proceed with a build. If the decision is to build, partners will then vote on a construction manager, capital campaign consultant, and financial package. We need you there, so be sure and put this date on your calendar!

ACTIVE LEARNING

We nurture preschoolers using developmentally appropriate practices that reach children so they are ready to learn while encouraging them to reach new goals. Curriculum is written in-house by Amy Cauble, SoJ Preschool Director, and continues to incorporate a variety of learning areas such as literacy, math, science, social skills, social studies, creative arts, and faith formation, through daily activities. Teachers interact with children through open-ended activities and hands-on play. Activities may also be supplemented by "Learning Without Tears" curriculum on occasion.

We look forward to adding a few new elements such as enriched music education with the help of Carli Bollin, SoJ's summer music coordinator, and enhanced "Love Your Neighbor" projects encouraging children to care for others.

FAITHFUL HEARTS

Children will experience Bible stories through weekly chapel time with our pastors, deacons, and other faith formation staff. Faith formation activities are also interwoven in all aspects of a Preschool day through activities such as prayers, games, snacks, songs, and crafts.
