It's been busy as Spirit of Joy. And, it's getting even busier!

We are still in the midst of the Christmas season. God IS with us. On our good days and our bad. In our doubts and fears. In our joys. And, in our sorrows.

Despite the lingering aroma of turkey and prime rib, the detritus of packages and guests, we are turning our heads towards Epiphany and towards the future of Spirit of Joy.

## In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in heaven." -Matthew 5:16

Think back to the beginning of the Sermon on the Mount. The disciples have learned who they are. Now, they need to know what difference this makes. I might summarize this section of the Sermon on the Mount this way, "Knowledge without action delays the Kingdom come."

We have a lot of information about Jesus, about God, about the Holy Spirit to share, but that's as far as it goes. It's one of my greatest struggles in discipleship. I love to learn, but what does it matter? And, I think it's true for others. We tend to amass information for information's sake and not for the sake of the difference it might make for another. In this section of the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus reminds us that knowledge about God cannot exist as simply knowledge. Knowledge about God, theology, if you will, is God's very presence in the world. It is not enough to know about God. As disciples, we must be the activity of God in the world. We are called to live out our identity as salt and light.


This season we will be focusing on how God is revealed among us and our call to "Shine" God's light for all the world to see. The gospel texts from January 8-February 19 each offer a glimpse into how God revealed God's self in Jesus. We'll allow Jesus' baptism to stand alone on January 8<sup>th</sup>, but the next week we'll pick up this theme in our liturgy, music, and preaching. From the confession of Nathaniel on January 15<sup>th</sup>, "We have found the Messiah", to the revelation from God, "This is my Son, the beloved, with whom I am well pleased on February 19<sup>th</sup>, we will explore our own callings and how God is revealed among us, as individuals, and as Spirit of Joy.

This work won't be limited to our gatherings for worship. Our conversation at Brewed Theology on January 9<sup>th</sup> will focus on vocation. On January 15<sup>th</sup> we'll celebrate our volunteers and the 250 hours per week that it takes to make Spirit of Joy go. Our 2023 Stewardship Campaign, "Extravagant Generosity: Beyond Dollars and Cents" will launch with weekly "Did You Know?" social media posts, monthly newsletter articles, and more, celebrating all of the ways our partners are living out their calling every day. And, we'll work to reinvigorate the work of "C3: Creating a Culture of Calling" through a deep dive into our discernment for the future direction of Spirit of Joy.

Join us, as we seek to be salt and light, as we put our knowledge into action, as we Shine!

#### Brene Brown Brown Bag


Begins January 15 @ Noon

#### Psalm 24:1 The earth is the Lord's and all that is in it, the world, and those who live in it

Peace to you from the Creation Care Team as we enter 2023. This season of light, Epiphany, we ponder how Jesus was revealed as the Light of the World.

We may also reflect on the word, <u>epiphany</u>. Merriam-Webster's third definition (after the Holy references) is as follows: 1. a usually sudden manifestation or perception of the <u>essential</u> nature or meaning of something 2. an intuitive grasp of reality through something (such as an event) usually simple and striking 3. an illuminating discovery, realization, or disclosure. What might we come to realize this new year?

Genesis 1:6-8 <sup>6</sup>And God said, "Let there be a dome in the midst of the waters, and let it separate the waters from the waters." <sup>7</sup>So God made the dome and separated the waters that were under the dome from the waters that were above the dome. And it was so. <sup>8</sup>God called the dome Sky.

The WHO estimates that at least 9 out of 10 people are residing in places with polluted air. In 2020 in the US, 68 million tons of air pollution were emitted into the atmosphere per the EPA.

Genesis 1:9-10 and 1:20 <sup>9</sup>And God said, "Let the waters under the sky be gathered together into one place, and let the dry land appear." And it was so. <sup>10</sup>God called the dry land Earth, and the waters that were gathered together he called Seas. And God saw that it was good...And God said, "Let the waters bring forth swarms of living creatures, and let birds fly above the earth across the dome of the sky."

How much plastic is dumped into the oceans each year? Up to 12 million metric tons is dumped into the ocean yearly, which is equal to about 100,000 blue whales. In fact, by 2050, ocean plastic will outweigh all of the ocean's fish. Indeed, there's so much junk out to sea that it's formed giant garbage patches; there are 5 of them around the world (the largest is called The Great Pacific Garbage Patch).

Psalm 96:11-13 <sup>11</sup>Let the heavens be glad, and let the earth rejoice; let the sea roar, and all that fills it; <sup>12</sup>let the field exult, and everything in it. Then shall the trees of the forest sing for joy <sup>13</sup>before the Lord; for he is coming, for he is coming to judge the earth. He will judge the world with righteousness, and the peoples with his truth.

From Professor Amy Marga's God Pause entry for 12/20/22: "...it is not just people who are rejoicing at the coming of Christ, but nature too. The earth rejoices; the sea roars, including all of its fish and crabs and whales. The trees sing for joy...science is showing us today that trees actually do communicate and have chemical community among one another. Animals have intricate relationships with one another, relationships that the human senses are often too dull to perceive."

Open our eyes and ears to the ways your creation is aching and crying out, Oh Lord, and guide us to action. Amen.

In December the preschool children explored the story of Jesus' birth in many ways: we read it from the Bible, sung songs, created from playdough and paper crafts, acted it out with props and even "met" important people from the story at Chapel time.

We also planned a short program of songs and story. Each time program songs were practiced; the children would jump and wiggle in delight while wearing a beaming smile. The excitement and joy were uncontainable! On December 21 & 22, the children were able to perform their program and tell the story, sharing the good news of Jesus' birth with others. ## 2022 Financial Wrap-Up

Thanks to our starting cash balance for 2022 and judicious use of designated funds, we will end the year with a **positive** balance in our general fund. But, the truth of the matter is that we have been, since the start of 2021, outspending our income an average of \$4000 per month. We've survived on the extraordinary gifts of December 2020. And, to put it quite simply, we can't continue doing that.

For 2023, we approved a Mission Plan of \$795,000. While that is an increase of just less than 4% (\$30,000) from our 2022 Mission Plan, that is \$175,000 more than our 2022 income.


## I like to think of that gap as the difference between who we are, and who we want to be.

Many of you have said "yes!" to our desire to grow, to reconnect our partners and build our relationships, and to building our dreams of becoming a house of prayer for all peoples. Of the commitments made for the 2023 Mission Plan, the average planned increase is 31%. Thank you to those of you who made the decision to grow your commitment to Spirit of Joy. If you haven't submitted your commitment to our 2023 Mission Plan you still can. It will help us to plan in the very near future as we discern God's call to Spirit of Joy and how we can faithfully respond.

This year's stewardship emphasis is called "Extravagant Generosity: Beyond Dollars and Cents". We launch our emphasis on January 15<sup>th</sup> with Volunteer Appreciation Sunday. While, of course, we want to be good stewards and transparent in our finances, we also want to celebrate all the other ways you give. Each week volunteers contribute more than 250 hours to the operation of Spirit of Joy. You are amazing! When you add the number of service hours to our community and on behalf of Spirit of Joy it is easy to say that you give 300 hours each week to bringing the kingdom of God near.

Thank you for your continued practice of Extravagant Generosity.


#### General Fund - Cash Balance Comparison
