

Spirit of Joy Leadership Team Meeting Minutes November 21, 2024 @ 6:30 p.m.

- I. New Business
 - A. Annual Meeting Agenda: Reviewed and discussed agenda for the Congregational meeting for Nov 24, 2024.
 - a. Constitution and Bylaw Amendments: Leadership team recommended forwarding the proposed amendment to the congregation for consideration.
 - b. Elections: Reviewed and finalized the proposed election ballot.
 - c. 2025 Budget
 - B. ERC Returns: Discussed the allocation of the ERC funds. A motion was made by Tiffany Mutchler to allocate the funds as follows: \$34,000 to repay the debt to the building fund, \$3,000 to Heather Wald for her additional time and effort in completing the application, and \$11,000 to the general fund. Laurie Gromer seconded the motion, which was approved unanimously by a voice vote.
 - C. 2025 Budget: Reviewed and discussed various options for the 2025 budget. A **motion** was made by Andrew Hewitt to approve the expense budget of \$932,631.68 for the 2025 fiscal year. The motion was seconded by Laurie Gromer and approved unanimously by a voice vote.

II. Meeting Review and Lord's Prayer: Motion by Kendra Krueger and second by Chad Wolff to adjourn meeting. Motion carried by voice vote. The meeting was closed with the Lord's Prayer.

Next Leadership Team Meeting is scheduled for Thursday, December 19 at 6:30 p.m.
