As I look back, I am so grateful for so many things: for the first pioneers who joined this mission start when Spirit of Joy was still just a dream; for those who took risks to invite strangers to join us; for the many musicians and artists who have enlivened our worship; for the leaders and planners who helped us take many strategic steps, and for many more who did thousands of little noticed things behind the scenes; for faith formation leaders for every age; for extravagant generosity that has funded our ministry for 20+ years, made us leaders in supporting community and global ministries, AND made it possible for us to build and expand our mission center; for staff who have shared leadership with skill and joy; and for your encouragement and support.

What a journey it has been! Thank you for calling me to serve as your pastor and for accompanying me in this fruitful ministry for these many years. I will continue to hold you in my heart and my prayers as we keep following Jesus together over different paths.

A Summer of Brene Brown w/ Margie Schade June 9, July 7, August 11 | 7 PM @ SoJ





Did You Know...?

- * Nearly 2 million plastic bags are used every minute?

- * If you haven't done so already, stop putting plastic bags and wrap in your recycling bin! They must be pulled out of the recycling by hand, and if not pulled out will quickly jam up the machines used for recycling other materials.

I. Unfinished Business

A. **Overflowing! Building Debt Reduction Appeal Update:** Pastor Jeff provided a progress report of the debt reduction appeal. To date there has been a commitment from 66 households for \$593,680 over the three-year period.

B. Welcome and Orientation for Deacon Candidate Hannah Fleming

- a. Moving Expenses: Motion by Kendra Krueger and second by Jason Ahrendt to use Thrivent Choice restricted funds for Hannah Fleming's moving expenses. Motion carried.
- b. First Week Welcome: Pastor Jeff and Deacon Katherine will host a potluck picnic for Hannah and her family, the SoJ Leadership Team and SoJ staff on Thursday, July 7th at the Eisele home.
- c. Ordination and Installation: Hannah will be ordained at Calvary Lutheran Church in Rapid City on Saturday, July 30, 2022. Discussed potential dates for installation at SoJ later in the summer.

II. New Business

- A. **Audit Committee:** Discussed potential candidates to serve on a committee to audit financial records. No action taken.
- B. **Synod Assembly Alternate Representatives-June 3-4, 2022:** Discussed alternate representatives to attend the Synod Assembly in June. Kendra Krueger may be able to attend.
- C. **Resignation of Call:** Pastor Jeff presented his letter of resignation of call to SoJ effective the end of August 2022. The Leadership Team accepted the letter with regret.
- **III. Meeting Review and Lord's Prayer:** The meeting was adjourned following the Lord's Prayer.

Next Leadership Team Meeting is scheduled for Thursday, June 16 at 6:30 p.m.
