

### Spirit of Joy Leadership Team Meeting Minutes

August 18, 2022 @ 6:30 p.m. at Spirit of Joy

#### **I. Unfinished Business**

- A. **Audit Committee Update:** The audit committee will conclude the audit at the end of August and will be reviewed by the Leadership Team at the September meeting.
- B. **Transportation Policy:** No action has been taken on the transportation policy. Previous transportation guidelines are in place until recommendations can be added to the policy.

#### **II. New Business**

A. Reconciling in Christ (RIC) Proposal: Madeline Trosvig and Pam Cole provided an overview of the RIC program and proposed that SoJ move forward with becoming a RIC congregation. Paul Johnston provided support of the proposal. "The purpose of the Reconciling in Christ (RIC) Program is to ensure the welcome, inclusion, celebration, and advocacy for people of all sexual orientations, gender identities, and gender expressions; work for racial equity and commit to anti-racist work and support the national program." Following discussion, the Leadership Team requested that Pastor Eric obtain additional information from the presenters and other congregations. The Leadership Team will revisit the topic in September.

#### **B. Pastoral Transitions:**

- 1. **Process for Moving Forward:** The Leadership Team discussed the plan and potential timeline for moving forward with a call for a lead pastor and an associate pastor.
- 2. **Call Committee: C13.05.** When a vacancy occurs in a position for which this congregation calls a rostered minister a **Call Committee** of six voting members shall be elected by this congregation. Term of office will terminate upon installation of the newly called rostered minister.
- 3. Congregation Meeting to Outline Process and Elect Call Committee: Kendra Krueger moved and Andrew Hewitt seconded to call a congregational meeting on September 18, 2022 to elect a call committee. Motion carried.
- C. **Choir Accompanist:** The Leadership Team discussed the addition of a choir accompanist. Action deferred until the September meeting.
- III. Meeting Review and Lord's Prayer: The meeting was adjourned following the Lord's Prayer.

Next Leadership Team Meeting is scheduled for Thursday, September 15, 2022 at 6:30 p.m.
