


Monthly updates on the mission & ministry of Spirit of Joy Lutheran Church

Peace to you

Now the birth of Jesus the Messiah took place in this way. When his mother Mary had been engaged to Joseph, but before they lived together, she was found to be with child from the Holy Spirit. Her husband Joseph, being a righteous man and unwilling to expose her to public disgrace, planned to dismiss her quietly. - Matthew 1:18-19



They all wondered what Joseph was going to do: the guys in the locker room, the other workers in his dad's shop, the Saturday School teachers at the synagogue, and certainly members of his family. "He's a good kid," everyone said.

"Too bad he got mixed up with the likes of her."

They had names for "her"—Mary—now pregnant before she and Joseph were married. The names were probably not much different than the names we used to refer to the girls in my high school who were suddenly, surprisingly "with child." All were cruel. No self-respecting guy would date let alone marry that kind of girl.

Joseph was caught in a dilemma: will he preserve his reputation as a "righteous man" and do what God's Law required (which is to terminate the relationship)? Or will he believe Mary's crazy story that her pregnancy is from God, marry her anyway, and throw away his reputation? He initially opted to keep his reputation intact by choosing a quiet end to the engagement. This was also the most merciful way to spare Mary any more public humiliation.

Then an angel tells Joseph *not to fear* and go ahead with the wedding plans. What did Joseph have to fear? That no one would ever refer to him as "righteous" again.

Scot McKnight writes in *The Jesus Creed* that, "Sometimes the implication of listening to the voice of God is that we ruin our reputation in the public square. Loving God ... involves surrendering ourselves to God in heart, soul, mind, strength—and reputation. The minute we turn exclusively to the Lord to find our true identity is *the day reputation dies*."

May you hear God's call this Advent as Joseph did—and may you discover that your identity as a servant of the Living God matters most of all.

Please prayerfully consider if you'd like to be on this mission trip. Events like these are monumental faith milestones!


Youth Group in December
