Spirit of Joy Library: Choosing Kindness



Wonder by R.J. Palacio is an interesting and uplifting novel for students about ages 8-12. It tells the story of 10-Church Library year old Auggie Pullman, who was born with severe facial deformities. Because of

many surgeries and other physical problems, Auggie had been home schooled up until fifth grade. Now he must face starting middle school and learning to handle all the crises of that year--cliques, popularity issues, bullying, etc.--and his classmates are also tested as they learn to accept him as an ordinary kid with an extraordinary face.

The story is told from several first-person perspectives, including Auggie himself, his sister, and some of his classmates. Auggie's parents, teachers and principal are also important characters. The author uses realistic conversation and humor to make the point that anyone and everyone can benefit from being treated, and treating others, with more kindness.

REACH Support

For the past several years members of Spirit of Joy have helped support teachers in India at the REACH Home. The support involves \$120 a year to provide an extra \$10 per month to add to the teacher's monthly income. This year we are requesting the same support. Each teacher receives an extra \$10 a month from these gifts added to their monthly \$50 income. Any help you could provide is very much appreciated. This REACH Home is run by Kusuma Paul, a personal friend of Dennis and Sandy Ellingsen. She houses, feeds, educates and cares for 300 orphans in India, and these teachers are a vital part of her ministry and calling. Thank you for your consideration. 
Book Clubs & Studies
